<b>Nomination Deadlines for Incoming Students</b>	For the following winter semester: <b>1 May</b> For the following summer semester: <b>1 October</b> Please note that the database will close after the deadline of 1 May and reopen on 15 July.
<b>Nomination Requirements</b>	Min. age: 18 years. Min. 2 semesters completed at the home institution before exchange.
<b>Application</b>	Online application (application details will be sent to the nominated students directly). The necessary personal information may be forwarded to the Austrian Federal Ministry for Europe, Integration and Foreign Affairs (BMEIA) in order to support the student's application for a visa/residence permit.
<b>Language Requirements</b>	CEFR B2 or equivalent in the language of instruction. Please note that in many study fields most of the courses are taught in German. For students studying German Studies at the University of Vienna the new required level of German is CEFR C1.
