Important Notes:

1. Please note that the available course list is for reference only. The approval of courses is at the discretion of respective faculty. Actual enrolment is subject to the availability of courses, quota and class schedule. [The information could be changed without prior notice.]
2. Some courses may have special enrolment requirements, e.g. prerequisite.
3. **Most CHIN courses are taught in Chinese.** Students can enrol in CHIN95xx courses to study Mandarin and Cantonese. Some CLL and Translation courses have additional language requirements.
4. At least 50% of the course load must be selected from Arts Faculty for Arts incoming exchange students. Students have the option to take the remaining credits from other faculties. Common Core courses will not be included in the 50% course enrolment requirement for incoming students.
5. Students are recommended to take 24-30 credits per semester (generally 6 credits per course) unless otherwise permitted or required by their home institution.
